Today: Cloudy through mid-morning, then gradual clearing, with a high near 54. North northwest wind 5 to 15 mph, with gusts as high as 20 mph.

Tonight: Mostly clear, with a low around 45. East northeast wind 5 to 10 mph becoming south southeast after midnight.

Incident Reports

019 District

21 OCT 2023, Arrest

A migrant who arrived on the 19th seeking shelter came to report today that another migrant who made a space for her and her children to sleep near him later put his hands on her. R/o made a report under [REDACTED]. Offender was pointed out and arrested at the time. Migrant wants to be relocated to another place because she fears that other migrants are upset that she signed complaints to have him arrested

017 District

21 OCT 2023, Community Concern

A neighbor who resides near the 17th District notified CPD that he and his neighbors are becoming frustrated with the decaying conditions in the alley caused by some migrants who are living in tents outside our station along the sidewalk from 3930 to 4000 W. Leland. CPD conducted an outdoor premise check of the alley behind the Leland Plaza from 4701 to 4729 N. Pulaski in response to the above complaint received from Armando Martinez regarding public urination and littering in the alley by migrants living in the tents nearby. Both members confirmed a strong urine smell in the alley behind the Leland Plaza and observed human feces on the brick walls of said plaza along with discarded open cans of liquor and other debris strewn about the alley. Above concerns and a request for assistance were documented on an Information Report (ID #13411). A City Service Request (no. SR23-01828687) seeking clean-up assistance was also submitted.

012 District

21 OCT 2023, Arrest

A migrant was arrested in the lobby for Sexual abuse/ battery. Victim alleges that the offender grabbed her breast while she was lying near him overnight. Desk crew was made aware of the issue after other migrants began threatening the offender.

022 District

20 OCT 2023, Arrest

- Migrant arrested for Battery on another migrant seeking shelter in that he punched the victim in the nose.
- The Domestic Battery arrestee from yesterday was released from custody and came back to 022. Due to the victim and her child still being sheltered here, and with cooperation from the 002nd District, was relocated to 002 for shelter.
