ALLEGATIONS

The complainant alleges she called the police several times to report neighbors threatening and throwing objects at her and her children and that the same two uniformed officers (one F/1 and one M/1) responded and took no action despite the fact that the individuals were still on the scene. The complainant further alleges that when she called to request a supervisor a M/2 officer wearing a white shirt responded but never got out of his vehicle to talk to complainant. The complainant further alleges that when the first supervisor arrived one of initial officers, whose name plate read Tate asked the complainant "What the hell you think that white man's gonna do for us niggers"?

R/SGT. ASSIGNED TO INVESTIGATE CR # 238431 BY CAPT. MERRITT WITH THE ALLEGATION THAT THE COMPLAINANT CALLED POLICE SEVERAL TIMES TO REPORT NEIGHBORS THREATENING AND THROWING OBJECTS AT HER AND HER CHILDREN AND THAT THE SAME TWO UNIFORMED OFFICERS (ONE MALE BLACK AND ONE FEMALE BLACK) RESPONDED AND TOOK NO ACTION, DESPITE THE FACT THAT THE INDIVIDUALS WERE ON THE SCENE. COMPLAINANT ALSO ALLEGED THAT WHEN SHE CALLED TO REQUEST A SUPERVISOR, A MALE WHITE OFFICER ,WEARING A WHITE SHIRT RESPONDED BUT NEVER GOT OUT OF HIS VEHICLE TO TALK TO THE COMPLAINANT, ADDITIONALLY WHEN THE FIRST SUPERVISOR ARRIVED, ONE OF THE INITIAL OFFICERS ,THE ONE WHOSE NAMEPLATE READ "TATE" ASKED COMPLAINANT,"WHAT THE HELL YOU THINK THAT WHITE MAN'S GONNA DO FOR US NIGGERS?"

R/SGT. ATTEMPTED TO MAKE CONTACT WITH THE COMPLAINANT, APRIL PEOPLES, NUMEROUS TIMES. R/SGT. CALLED ON 20 JUL 97 AT ABOUT 1900 HRS AND AGAIN ABOUT 2055 HRS BUT THERE WAS NO ANSWER. R/SGT. TRIED AGAIN ON 23 JUL 97 BUT AGAIN THERE WAS NO ANSWER. ON 31 JUL 97 R/SGT. WENT TO THE HOUSE AT [REDACTED] BUT NO ONE WAS AT HOME. ON 8 AUG 97 R/SGT. CALLED AND FOUND THAT THE PHONE WAS DISCONNECTED. ANOTHER ATTEMPT 18 AUG 97 AND THE PHONE WAS STILL DISCONNECTED. R/SGT. SENT A CERTIFIED LETTER ON 19 AUG 97 AND ON 21 AUG 97 AGAIN WENT TO THE HOME. R/SGT. SPOKE TO A NEIGHBOR, [REDACTED] WHO RELATED THAT SHE BELIEVED [REDACTED] HAD MOVED . ON 26 AUG 97 THE CERTIFIED LETTER WAS RETURNED TO R/SGT WITH RETURN TO SENDER/NO FORWARDING ADDRESS ON FILE.

IN AN EFFORT TO IDENTIFY THE ACCUSED OFFICERS SINCE THERE ARE THREE OFFICERS NAMED TATE ON THE 3RD WATCH R/SGT. REQUESTED THE OEC TAPE AND A TRANSCRIPT WITH AN ADDRESS HISTORY FROM 15 JUL 97 DURING THE TIME SPAN INVOLVED. R/SGT RECEIVED THESE FROM OEC AND READ THE PRINTOUTS OF CALLS RECEIVED FROM THAT ADDRESS ON THAT NIGHT AND ALSO LISTENED TO THE TAPE . ACCORDING TO TRANSCRIPTS AND TAPE BT. 355 WAS THE FIRST CAR TO RESPOND TO A DISTURBANCE WITH NEIGHBORS KIDS HITTING GOLF BALLS TOWARDS THEIR CAR. BT.355 WAS DISPATCHED AT 1742 AND CAME CLEAR WITH A 5P AT 1818. BT. 355 ON THAT DATE HAD A M/W OFFICER AND A M/B OFFICER SINCE THE COMPLAINT SPECIFICALLY STATES A F/B & M/B OFFICER. R/SGT. DID NOT INCLUDE THESE OFFICERS AMONG THE ACCUSED. A SECOND CALL AT 1918 HRS THE COMPLAINANT STATES IT STARTED WITH THE CHILDREN BUT NOW THE ADULTS ARE ARGUING ABOUT THE CHILDREN. AT 1951 HRS BT. 358 (P.O. VELVA WINES # 3154 A F/B OFFICER WORKING ALONE AT THAT TIME) WAS DISPATCHED

(CONTINUED) TO THE DISTURBANCE AND BT. 353 (P.O. JOHNNY TATE # 13358 & P.O. KEVIN DRUMGOOLE # 19047 BOTH M/B OFFICERS) WAS DISPATCHED TO ASSIST. AT 2027 HRS. BT.332 (P.O. PATRICE HARPER # 5676 , A F/B OFFICER & P.O. MICHAEL HUNTER # 18555, A M/B OFFICER) CAME UP ON THE AIR AND TOLD THE DISPATCHER THAT THEY ALSO WERE ASSISTING BT. 358 & 353 ON [REDACTED] AT ABOUT 2023 HRS WHILE ALL OF THE ABOVE UNITS WERE STILL ON THE SCENE, THE COMPLAINANT AGAIN CALLED 911 AND REQUESTED A SGT. BT.350 (SGT.G.OWEN # 945) WAS DISPATCHED TO THE SCENE AT 2024. BT. 330(SGT. R. WHEELER) ALSO RESPONDED TO THE SCENE BUT AFTER LEARNING FROM P.O.WINES THAT BT.350 WAS ENROUTE, BT. 330 LEFT . AT THIS POINT ON THE TAPE THE COMPLAINANT STATES THAT SHE CALLED 2 DAYS AGO & THE POLICE ARE ALL OUT THERE ' [REDACTED] WITH HER NEIGHBORS AND SHAKING HANDS AND STUFF AND THAT NOW SHE WANTED SOMEBODY HIGHER THAN A SGT TO COME. SHE ALSO STATED SHE WANTED A REPORT AND THAT OFFICER TATE TOLD HER SHE COULD HAVE A REPORT TO SHOW TO HER LANDLORD. AT THIS POINT A CHILD'S VOICE IS HEARD SAYING "MAMA,MAMA THAT LADY WANTS TO TALK TO YOU" AND THE COMPLAINANT REPLIES " WHAT DO YOU WANT, WHAT LADY?" AND THE CHILD'S VOICE SAYS " THE POLICE LADY". THE COMPLAINANT THEN SAYS " I DON'T WANT TO TALK TO HER OR NO MORE POLICE OFFICERS". THE COMPLAINANT THEN CONTINUES ON REQUESTING A NUMBER FOR OPS FROM THE DISPATCHER/CALL TAKER AT OEC. BT.358,353 & 332 WENT CLEAR FROM THE JOB AT 2036 HRS. BT.350 RESPONDED TO THE SCENE AND REQUESTED BT. 358 TO RETURN TO THE SCENE TO TAKE A REPORT. BT.358 (AT THIS TIME A 10-4 UNIT WITH P.O. R. CARTER # 19488) MADE A SIMPLE ASSAULT CASE REPORT UNDER RD [REDACTED] ATT.# 26). SGT. OWEN THEN OBTAINED THE ABOVE COMPLAINT REGISTER NUMBER FROM OPS.

R/SGT. SERVED P.O.'S TATE, JOHNNY # 13358, DRUMGOOLE, KEVIN # 19047,HUNTER,MICHAEL # 18555, HARPER,PATRICE # 5676 AND WINES, VELVA # 3154 WITH THE NOTIFICATIONS OF CHARGES/ALLEGATIONS, THE ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS RIGHTS AND THE WAIVER/REQUEST COUNSEL FORMS.

IN AN IN PERSON INTERVIEW, P.O. JOHNNY TATE # 13358 STATED IN A TO-FROM-SUBJECT REPORT, IN SUMMARY & NOT VERBATIM, THAT WHILE WORKING BT.353 HE ASSISTED BT.358 ON A CALL OF A DISTURBANCE AT [REDACTED] ON 15 JUL 97 . P.O. TATE STATES AT NO TIME DID HE MAKE THE STATEMENT ALLEGED TO HAVE BEEN MADE BY HIM TO THE COMPLAINANT. HE FURTHER STATED THAT HE HANDLES HIMSELF IN A PROFESSIONAL MANNER AND WOULD NEVER DISRESPECT HIMSELF OR OTHERS BY MAKING SUCH A STATEMENT.

IN AN IN PERSON INTERVIEW, P.O. VELVA WINES # 3154 STATED IN A TO-FROM-SUBJECT REPORT, IN SUMMARY AND NOT VERBATIM, THAT SHE WAS WORKING BT.358 ON 15 JUL 97 AT ABOUT 2035 HRS AND SHE WAS 10-99 . SHE WAS

10 NOV 97

(CONTINUED) ASSIGNED TO A DISTURBANCE CALL AT [REDACTED] SHE WAS ASSISTED BY BT.353 AND BT.332 . WHEN SHE ARRIVED THE COMPLAINANT STATED THERE HAD BEEN A DISTURBANCE BETWEEN HER BOYFRIEND AND THE NEIGHBORS BUT HER BOYFRIEND WAS NOT HOME AT THIS TIME. P.O.WINES AND THE ASSISTING UNITS THEN TALKED TO THE NEIGHBORS. WHILE THEY WERE SPEAKING TO THE NEIGHBORS THE COMPLAINANT'S BOYFRIEND ARRIVED HOME AND PEACE WAS RESTORED. COMPLAINANT AT NO TIME STATED THAT ANY CRIME HAD BEEN COMMITTED BY ANYONE . THIS WAS THE FIRST TIME THAT P.O.WINES HAD RESPONDED TO A CALL AT THIS ADDRESS ON THIS DATE. P.O. WINES ALSO STATED THAT BT.330 RESPONDED TO THE SCENE BUT BT. 350 HAD ALREADY BEEN DISPATCHED. SHE STATED SHE RESPONDED BACK TO THE SCENE UNDER THE DIRECTION OF BT. 350 AND WROTE THE REPORT UNDER RD# 437519.

R/SGT.CONDUCTED AN IN PERSON INTERVIEW OF P.O. KEVIN DRUMGOOLE # 19047 AND IN A TO-FROM-SUBJECT REPORT P.O.DRUMGOOLE STATED IN SUMMARY AND NOT VERBATIM, THAT HE ALONG WITH OFFICER I TATE WORKED BT. 353 ON 15 JUL 97. THEY ASSISTED BT. 358 AT [REDACTED] ON A DISTURBANCE CALL. AT NO TIME DID HE HEAR OFFICER TATE OR ANY OTHER OFFICER ON THE SCENE MAKE MAKE THE ALLEGED REMARKS TO THE COMPLAINANT.

R/SGT. CONDUCTED AN IN PERSON INTERVIEW OF P.O.MICHAEL HUNTER # 18555 AND IN A TO-FROM-SUBJECT REPORT P.O.HUNTER STATED, IN SUMMARY AND NOT VERBATIM THAT HE WAS WORKING BT.332 WITH P.O.PATRICE HARPER AS HIS PARTNER ON 15 JUL 97 AT APPROXIMATELY 2035 HRS. HE STATED THEY NEVER RESPONDED TO A CALL AT THIS ADDRESS PRIOR TO THE ABOVE CALL. HE STATED HE HAS NO KNOWLEDGE OF ALLEGATIONS MADE AGAINST ANY OTHER OFFICERS AT THE SCENE. HE STATED THEY WERE ON THE SCENE TO ASSIST BT 358 WHO WAS A 10-99 UNIT RESPONDING TO A DISTURBANCE CALL.

R/SGT. CONDUCTED AN IN PERSON INTERVIEW OF P.O. PATRICE HARPER # 5676 AND IN A TO-FROM SUBJECT REPORT P.O. HARPER STATED IN SUMMARY & NOT VERBATIM, THAT SHE WAS WORKING BT. 332 WITH HER PARTNER, P.O.HUNTER ON 15 JUL 97. THEY ASSISTED BT.358 A 99 UNIT AT A DISTURBANCE CALL AT [REDACTED] SHE STATED SHE HAD NO KNOWLEDGE OF THE ALLEGED COMMENTS MADE BY OFFICERS AT THE SCENE. SHE FURTHER STATED THAT THEY RESPONDED TO MANY CALLS FOR SERVICE ON THAT DAY AND PROVIDED PROPER POLICE SERVICE TO ALL REQUESTS FOR POLICE SERVICE.

R/SGT. HAS INCLUDED VARIOUS DOCUMENTS USED TO INVESTIGATE THE ABOVE CR NUMBER AS ATTACHMENTS.
