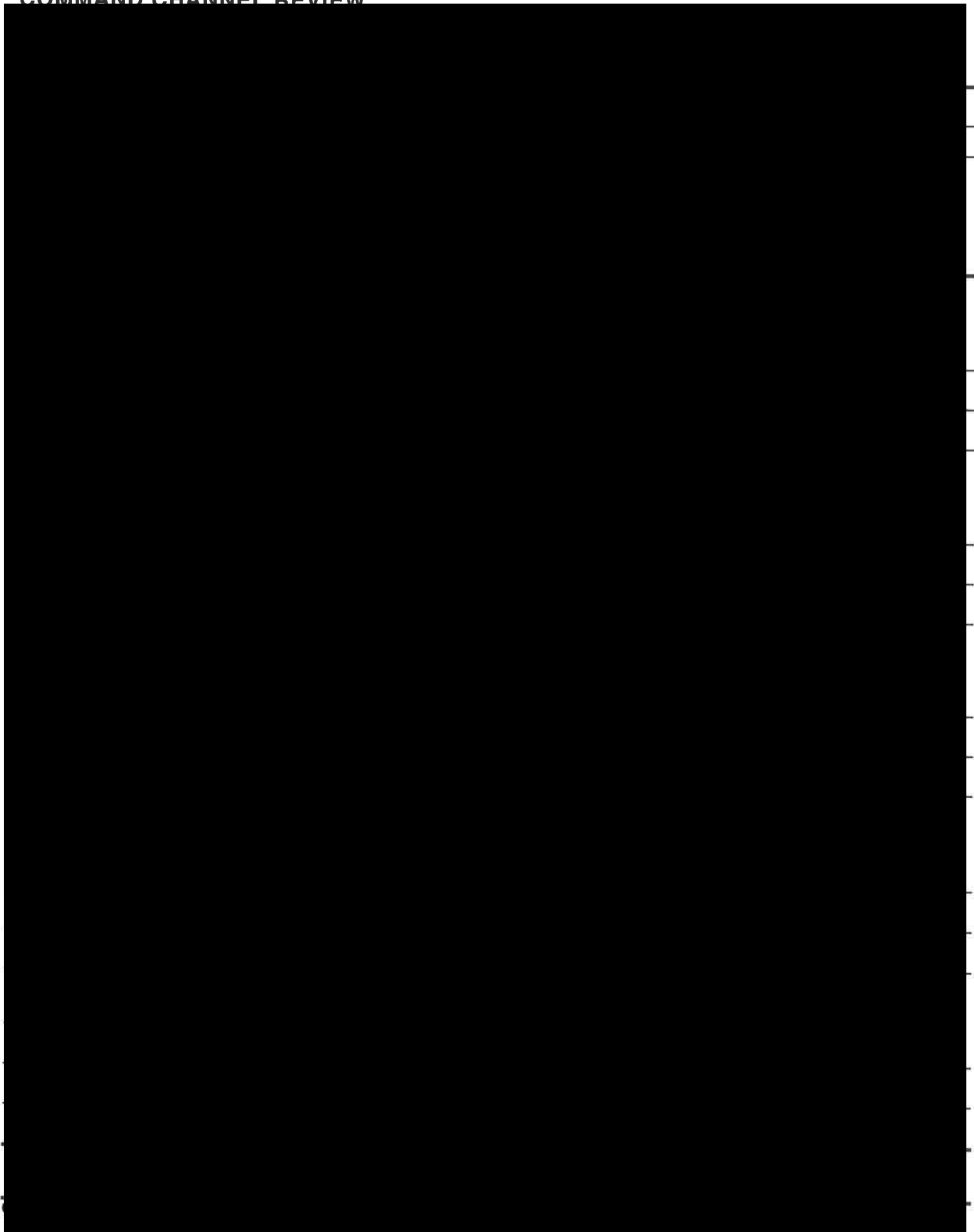

**ALLEGATIONS**

**ALLEGATION #1-** Complainant alleges that a M-2 officer (P.O. M SEISER #4615) refused to file a Traffic Accident Report regarding a male driver who struck her parked vehicle.

**ALLEGATION # 2-** Complainant alleges that a M-2 Sgt. ( Michael WILSON #2365) gave her misleading information in that he told her to call "311" to file a Traffic Accident Report.

Briefly summarize the investigation describing your efforts to prove or disprove the allegation(s). Indicate whether witnesses or evidence support or do not support the allegation(s). In sustained cases ONLY, copies of the accused member's Summary of Previous Disciplinary Actions and Record of Previous Complimentary History will be included as attachments.

R/Lt. conducted an interview by telephone [REDACTED] with Complainant, [REDACTED] N on 14 Oct 11 at 1420hrs. She related that on 30 Aug 11 her unattended, parked vehicle was involved in an accident. Complainant went to her vehicle, found damages and came into 018 to file a report. Complainant further states that when P.O. SEISER ( P.O. assigned to original call) arrived in the station, he said he did not make a Traffic Accident Report on scene and didn't get the driver information from the striking unit.

Complainant states that P.O. SEISER refused to give her a report and when she spoke to the Sgt. at the front desk, (Michael WILSON) he told her to call "311", which she did and was sent back to 018. Complainant states that she still has not been given a report.

Complainant arrived in 018 on 17 Oct 11 where she signed an Affidavit. At this time R/Lt stated he would give Complainant a Traffic Accident Report but she refused.

Sgt. WILSON and P.O. M. SEISER were given Administrative Rights and Waiver of Counsel/Request To Secure Counsel on 04 Nov 11. Both submitted To/From Reports.

P.O. SEISER relates in his report that the Complainant was not on scene at the time of the occurrence and that the vehicles were drivable. P.O. SEISER also states that the driver put his information on Complainants windshield and stated he was going into 018 to make a report. P.O. SEISER states he never refused to give Complainant a Traffic Accident Report.

Sgt. WILSON states in his report that does not recall advising any citizen to report a traffic accident to "311" non-emergency, as it is not reporting procedure.



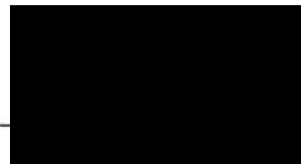

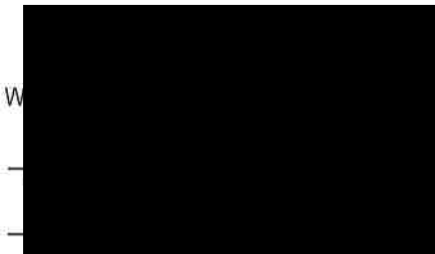

Complainant states that when P.O. SEISER (P.O. assigned to the original call) arrives in the station, he states he didn't make a Traffic Accident Report on scene and didn't get the driver information from the striking unit.

Complainant further states that P.O. SEISER refused to give her a report and when she spoke to the Sgt. at the front desk, (Sgt. WILSON) he told her to call "311", which she did and was referred back to 018 to make the report.

Complainant arrived in 018 on 17 Oct 11 and signed a Affidavit. At this time R/Lt. stated to Complainant that he would give her a Traffic Accident Report and she refused. Affidavit was faxed to IAD and copy sent via CPD mail.

Sgt. WILSON and P.O. SEISER were given Administrative Rights and Waiver Of Counsel/Request To Secure Counsel on 04 Nov 11. Both submitted TO/FROM Reports.

P.O. SEISER relates in his report that the Complainant was not on scene at the time of the accident and that the vehicles were drivable. P.O. SEISER further states that the driver of the striking vehicle put his information on the windshield of the Complainant's car and stated that he was going into 018 to make a report. P.O. SEISER states that he never refused to give Complainant a Traffic Accident Report.
