This complaint was received by Police Agent Calvin HOLLIDAY, Star 10865 of Unit 121C, for investigation and recommendation on 03 April 2001.

The investigator contacted both Sergeants Tyler PARTYKA and [REDACTED] of the Public Housing North Section and set up meetings with their informants and themselves. In the conversations with all, there was no information given which gave credence to the allegations made against Officer BRICE. The investigator also spoke with [REDACTED] regarding her statements about Officer BRICE. She also had no direct knowledge of any misconduct by Officer BRICE. Patrol Specialist Kenny LUNSFORD of the 18th District was contacted. He also gave information which was not conclusive regarding Officer BRICE and his alleged gang connections. The investigator conducted surveillances in an attempt to observe Officer BRICE interacting with gang members in the Cabrini Green buildings given in the statements of the before mentioned persons. They were negative in their results.

After speaking with the persons above, using the given information, this investigation supports a finding of **Not Sustained**. Officer BRICE is and has been a Public Housing officer for such a period of time as to possibly well know either on sight or by name, many of the occupants. The vast majority of the times it was said Officer BRICE was observed, he was working and in uniform. No one has been able to provide any information about Officer BRICE that demonstrates any misconduct or wrong doing by the accused. There is No evidence to prove there is a six pointed star tattooed on the accused. even if there was, it does not prove him to be a gang member.
