On 21 October 1998, at 1615 hours, the undersigned conducted a telephone interview with the complainant, [Redaction] regarding the allegations contained in Civil Suit Number [Redaction]. [Redaction] declined an interview of himself or his client, [Redaction] due to pending litigation.

Police Officer Melvin ECTOR submitted a To-From-Subject Report on 1 December 1998, in response to the allegation contained in the aforementioned civil suit. Officer ECTOR stated that at no time on 30 December 1996, or any other time, at [Redaction] [Redaction] did he unlawfully search or seize [Redaction]. The accused denied all allegations made by the complainant.

COMPLAINT

Plaintiff, Dezel Jones, by his attorney, Redaction complaining of defendant  
alleges as follows:

COUNT 1

1. This cause of action arises for damages and appropriate relief under 42 U.S.C. 1983, in that defendants, who are federal CHA police, violated plaintiff's civil rights by unlawfully seizing and searching him in violation of the Fourth Amendment of the United States Constitution.

2. At all times relevant to this cause of action, plaintiff did and does reside in Chicago, Cook County, Illinois.

3. On or about December 30, 1996, while in the vicinity of Redaction defendant did unlawfully seize and search the person of the plaintiff, without plaintiff's consent and without a search warrant, even though defendant knew plaintiff was not involved in any activity that could be described as unlawful or criminal.

4. The seizure and search of plaintiff Redaction was unreasonable and illegal.



1. This report is not being given voluntarily but under duress. I am only giving this report at this time because I know I could lose my job under Administrative Proceedings Rights if I refuse to do so.

2. On 30 December 1996 at [Redaction] the R/S, while assigned as a tactical officer to Public Housing South along with P.O. M. Ector # 4134, took [Redaction] into custody pursuant to a narcotics surveillance and arrest in which [Redaction] was found to have in excess of one hundred and twenty five grams of crack cocaine in his possession. The Circuit Court of Cook County Criminal Division found, on two occasions that the R/S and his partners had probable cause to arrest [Redaction] however, a judge unfamiliar with narcotic transactions on the south side of Chicago found it unlikely for a defendant to be in possession of that amount of cocaine during daylight hours, and granted [Redaction]' counsel motion to suppress, which nullified the prosecution.

3. The R/S and PO ECTOR acted within the parameters of the law and departmental policy during their investigation, and apprehension of, [Redaction] [Redaction] filed the frivolous lawsuit in order to harass and retaliate against the R/S and PO ECTOR, as the R/S and ECTOR defeated him in various criminal cases in which he was the acting counsel of, and also to prompt the city to pay him in order to dismiss the lawsuit. [Redaction] filed a previous similar lawsuit against the R/S and PO ECTOR in December 1997; RE: case [Redaction] CR# 232508. It should be noted that [Redaction] filed the lawsuit, even though the R/S and ECTOR were not the arresting officers in the aggrieved case which led to the lawsuit being dismissed in federal court.

4. The R/S believes that [Redaction] actions are in violation of the Illinois Supreme Court Rules governing the conduct of attorneys, and is presently filing a complaint with the Attorney's Registration and Disciplinary Commission regarding [Redaction] actions.
