SUMMARY

In an attempt to prove or disprove the allegations, the R/S interviewed the complainant and the witnesses as well as the accused members involved in the incident. During the interview of the complainant, it was ascertained that she could not furnish the names of the officers involved but merely a description of the officers' clothing. The R/S set up an appointment for the complainant to view the photographs of the members assigned to Unit 715. Through the Department's Digital Photo System, the complainant identified PO Melvin Ector as the officer who was verbally abusive. Additional allegations were made by the complainant. She related and identified PO Nathan Silas Jr. as the officer who searched her apartment without her permission and PO Glenn Evans as the officer who disseminated information relative to her being a victim of a crime. The R/S interviewed the witnesses, [Redacted] who related the same as the complainant relative to PO Ector being verbally abusive. It should be noted that neither witness mentioned anything relative to the complainant's allegation that PO Silas Jr. searched the apartment. The R/S interviewed [Redacted] relative to the allegation against PO Evans. Both witnesses related the same the complainant.

Officer Ector was presented with Notification of Charges/Allegations and related administrative forms. Officer Ector submitted a report in response to the allegations in which he denied the allegations. Witness reports were obtained from the other officers involved in incident and these reports denied the allegations made by the complainant. Officer Silas Jr. was presented Notification of Charges/Allegations and related administrative forms. Officer Silas Jr. submitted a report in response to the allegation in which he denied the allegation. Witness reports were obtained from the other officers involved in the incident and these reports denied the allegation. Officer Evans was presented with Notification of Charges/Allegations and related administrative forms. Officer Evans submitted a report in which he denied the allegation. A witness report was obtained from the other officer involved in the

[Redaction] identified Police Officer Michael Stanley as [Redaction] Police Officer Melvin Ector as the officer using the profanity; Police Officer Nathan Silas as the officer who searched her apartment; and Police Officer Glenn Evans as the officer who disseminated information to her boyfriend relative to her being a victim of a sexual assault. [Redaction] was not able to identify the fourth officer.

It should be noted that the identity of this officer is known to the R/S subsequent to a review of the initiation report. The R/S had the complainant view photographs to ascertain which officer is being accused of misconduct.




