ALLEGATIONS  
On 13 May 05 at 2030 hours, Complainant **[REDACTED]**, who did not witness the incident, telephoned the Office of Professional Standards and registered this complaint on behalf of **[REDACTED]** with OPS Civilian Intake Aide, Stacey Tolliver, Employee # **[REDACTED]**, Unit 113. **[REDACTED]** alleged that on 12 May 05, at approximately 1900 hours, at **[REDACTED]**, **PO John J. Dowling #19486**: (1) Grabbed him by his throat; (2) Held him by his throat while PO Hayes punched him; (3) Planted narcotics on him; and (4) Twisted and bent his wrist. He further alleged that during the same incident, **PO Timothy J. Hayes #7308**: (1) Repeatedly punched him about the face and head.

The following investigation was conducted in this matter:

Allegations made by the alleged victim, [REDACTED] are indicated in the allegations section of the summary report. Inv. Kamalick #282, indicated that [REDACTED] had an outward bulge to his cheek, swelling to the outside of his right eye, and redness and puffiness to the left side of his throat. According to [REDACTED] he sustained stiffness and soreness to his left wrist. He received medical treatment twice from Mercy Hospital. (Att. 6A, 7, 9A, 9B).

Attempts to interview witness and co-arrestee, [REDACTED] were met with negative results. (Att. 21, 33).

ET photos and mug shot photographs of [REDACTED] reveal that he has swelling to the right side of his face, an abrasion to the right side of his face, near his eye, and scratches on his wrist. (Atts. 5, 5A, 5B, 15A-O).

Medical records obtained from Mercy Hospital indicate that [REDACTED] was treated twice on 13 May 05. [REDACTED] was first treated at 0126 hours for eye, jaw and throat pain and diagnosed as having a hematoma of the right lower eyelid. [REDACTED] also complained of having difficulty swallowing. He was given a prescription for ointment, his eye was cleansed and x-rays were taken. [REDACTED] was discharged from the hospital at 0455 hours. [REDACTED] was transported back to the hospital at 1356 hours complaining of shortness of breath. [REDACTED] was treated for his asthma with Predisone and Albuterol. He was released at 1645 hours. (Atts. 9A, 9B).

A canvass of the area revealed no new witnesses. (Att. 22, 22A).

Department reports indicate that [REDACTED] was arrested for PCS, Resisting a PO, Expired L/P Sticker, D/L Revoked and No Insurance. [REDACTED] was also arrested for POC. TRR's indicated that PO Dowling used force which consisted of member presence, verbal commands, escort holds, wristlock, and takedown emergency handcuffing procedures. PO Hayes used force that consisted of his member presence, verbal commands, wristlock, open hand strike and takedown emergency handcuffing procedures. (Atts. 2- 4, 4A, 16, 17, 18).

Investigation Continued:

In a To-From Subject Report, Accused Officer John J. Dowling, #19486, related that he was on routine patrol in a high narcotic area when he and his partner, PO Hayes noticed [REDACTED] the driver of a vehicle with an expired license plate sticker. A traffic stop was conducted and they noticed that [REDACTED] was holding a clear plastic bag containing a white rock like substance, rock Cocaine. He further stated that [REDACTED] was asked to place the vehicle in park. According to PO Dowling, [REDACTED] tried to conceal the narcotics under his buttocks and refused all verbal commands and directions. [REDACTED] failed to adhere to the commands given to him a second time, at which time PO Dowling opened the driver's side door and applied a wristlock to this left hand. [REDACTED] flailed his left arm and pulled away freeing himself. He then put the vehicle in reverse, causing it to move backward and PO Dowling to run along side it to avoid being run over and it being an imminent threat of battery. At this point, PO Hayes had entered the passenger side door and was able to put the vehicle into park. After several more verbal commands, [REDACTED] resisted by attempting to kick him and by attempting to place the vehicle back into the drive position [REDACTED] was ordered to stop resisting, at which time, PO Hayes placed [REDACTED] in a wrist lock removing his right hand from the gear shift and ordered him again to stop resisting. Again [REDACTED] refused, and PO Hayes applied an open hand stun to the right eye/temple area of [REDACTED], thus enabling the officers to use the emergency handcuff takedown procedures. PO Dowling denied the allegations made against him, and denied observing the allegations made against PO Hayes. (Att. 26).

In a To-From Subject Report, Accused Officer Timothy J. Hayes #7308, essentially related the same information as his partner, PO Dowling. He further related that [REDACTED] was an active resister, whose demeanor was of desperation and sheer panic. PO Hayes added that when PO Dowling applied a wristlock to [REDACTED] flailed his arms and tried to free himself, thus resulting in PO Dowling being sandwiched between the open car door and the vehicle being placed in reverse. PO Hayes that when he jumped halfway into the passenger's side vehicle, he landed on the passenger, [REDACTED] in an attempt to prevent [REDACTED] from continuing to drive in reverse. PO Hayes denied the allegations against him and denied observing the allegations made against PO Dowling. (Att. 30).

Conclusion:

The R/I recommends a finding of Not Sustained for Allegation #1 that PO Dowling grabbed him by his throat. PO Dowling denied the allegation, however [REDACTED] complained to hospital personnel of having shortness of breath and trouble swallowing. Furthermore, Inv. Kamalick noted that he observed redness and puffiness to the left side of [REDACTED] throat. Therefore, there is insufficient evidence to prove or disprove the allegation. The R/I recommends a finding of Not Sustained for Allegation #2 that PO Dowling held him by his throat while PO Hayes punched him. PO Dowling denied the allegation. PO Hayes admitted to giving an open hand stun to [REDACTED]. Therefore, there is not enough evidence to refute or prove the allegation. The R/I recommends a finding of Unfounded for Allegation #3 that PO Dowling planted narcotics on [REDACTED] [REDACTED] has had numerous narcotic related arrests. Furthermore, in his ET and mug shot photos [REDACTED] appeared to having been under the influence of alcohol or drugs. The R/I recommends a finding of Exonerated for Allegation #4 in that PO Dowling twisted and bent his wrist. PO Dowling admitted using a wristlock technique on [REDACTED] and there is nothing wrong with an officer using this technique to place an offender under arrest. [REDACTED] admitted to having resisted and wrestled with the officers during his arrest.

The R/I recommends a finding of Unfounded for Allegation #1 that PO Hayes repeatedly punched [REDACTED] about the face and head. PO Hayes denied the allegation. Furthermore, Inv. Kamalick noted that he observed an outward bulge to [REDACTED] cheek, and swelling to the outside of his right eye. Hospital records indicated that [REDACTED] was diagnosed as having a hematoma of the right lower eyelid. However, [REDACTED] admitted to having resisted and wrestled with the officers during his arrest, thus some of the injury to his face was most likely caused when he resisted and wrestled with the officers, and not as a result of [REDACTED] passive action.

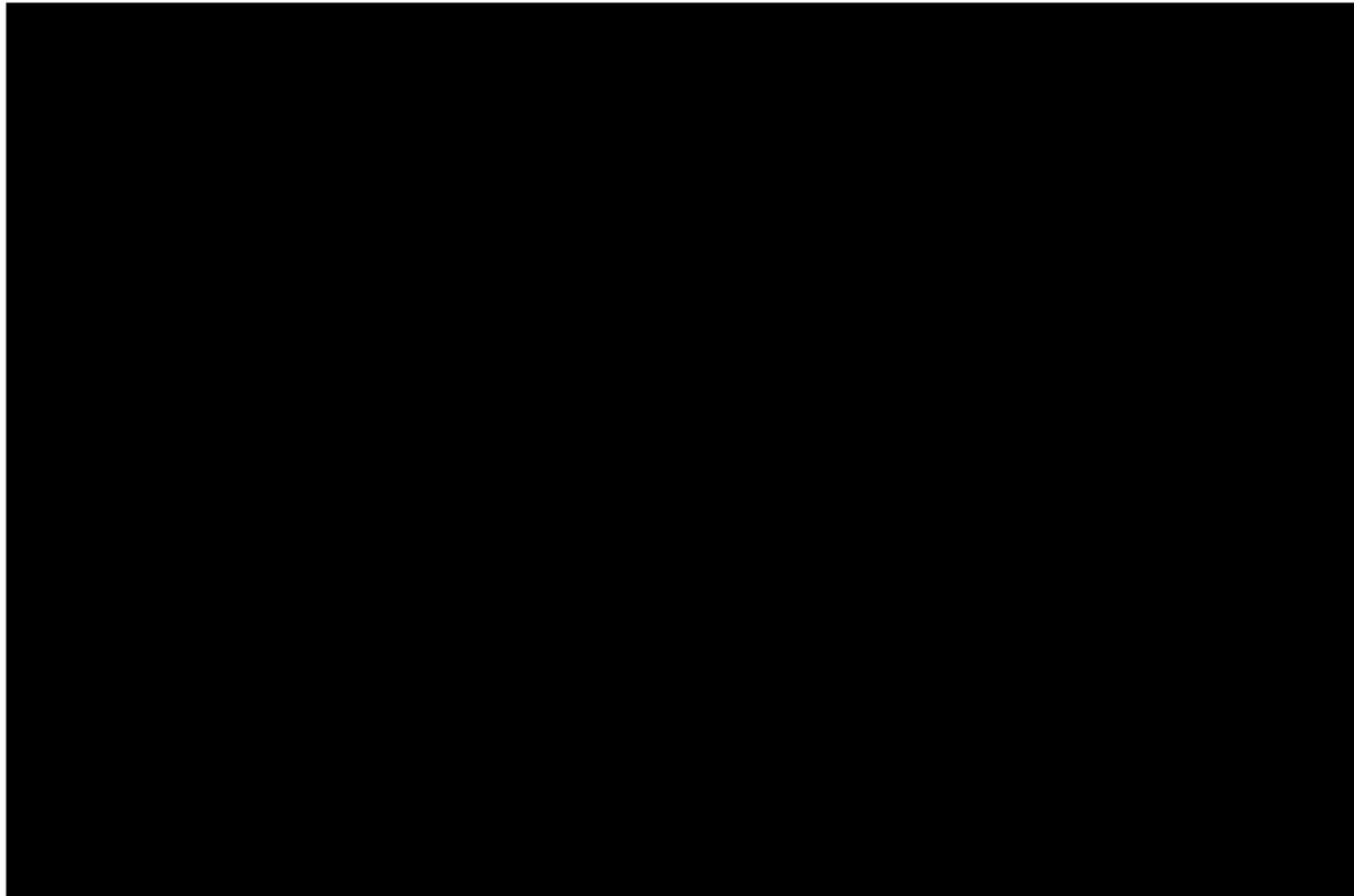

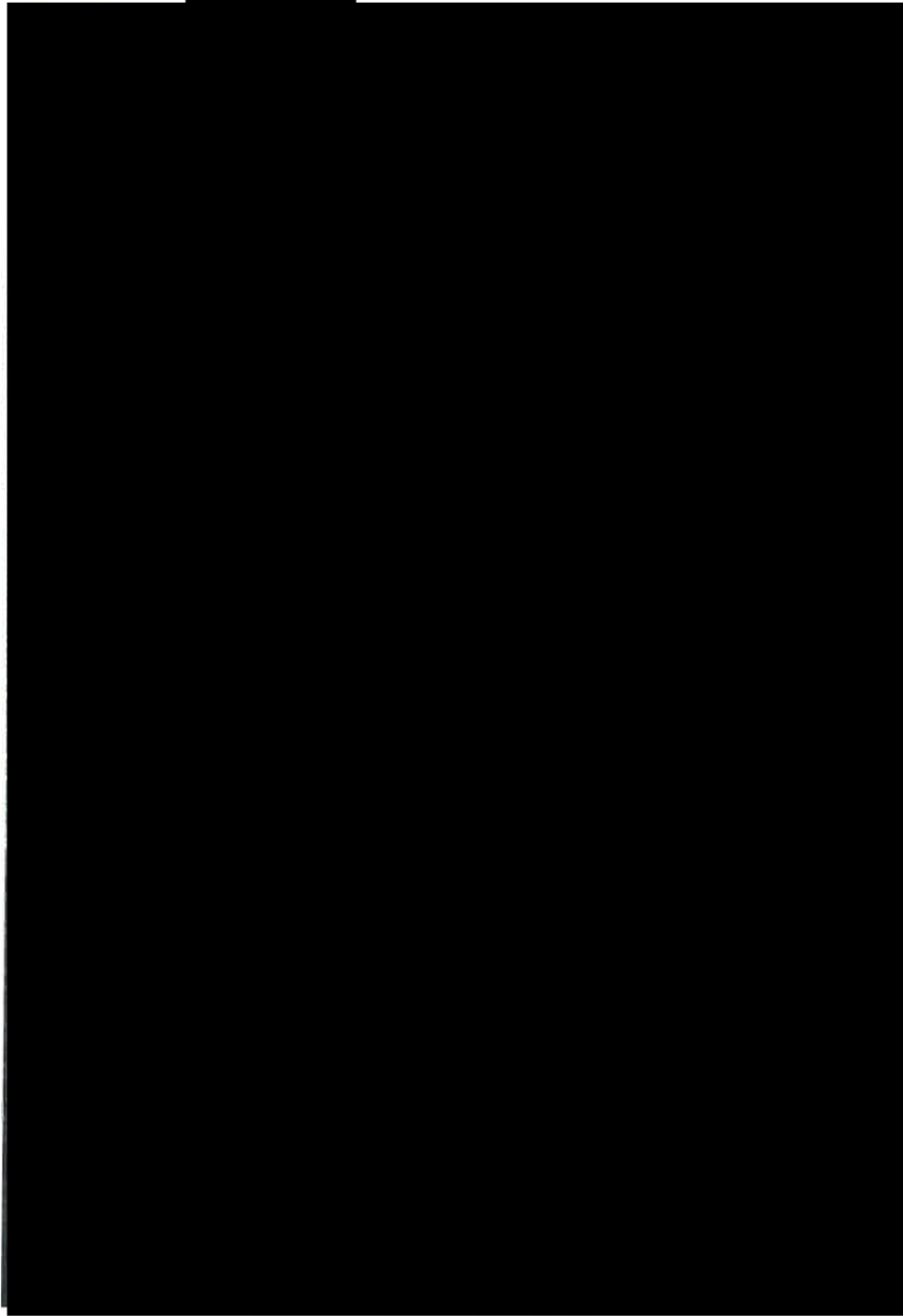

On Friday, 13 May 2005, at approximately 2241 hours, at the conclusion of the interview with Victim [REDACTED] the R/I asked [REDACTED] to indicate where he alleged to have been injured during the incident.

[REDACTED] pointed to his right cheek where an approximate 1 1/4" vertical bulge was evident. The bulge protruded outward from [REDACTED] cheek about 1/4" to 1/2".

There was also an approximate 1/4" bulge swelling outward from the outside of [REDACTED] right eye. These areas of swelling, [REDACTED] said, were attributed to an officer striking him on that side of the head numerous times with his fist.

[REDACTED] then displayed some redness and puffiness to the left side of his throat where he stated an officer grabbed him.

[REDACTED] further complained of stiffness and soreness to his left wrist, where he said the same officer who punched him on the head and held him by the throat also twisted and bent his left wrist. The R/I observed no visible sign of physical injury to [REDACTED] left wrist.

[REDACTED] complained of no other physical injury resulting from the incident.

This statement is not being given voluntarily, but under duress. I am only giving this statement at this time because I know that I could lose my job if I refuse the direct order being given to me. This **"To-From"** report should not be considered a verbatim statement but only a summary of requested information.

R/O, on the date and time in question, was on duty, in civilian clothes, and patrolling in an unmarked vehicle. Yes, R/O was in the vicinity of [REDACTED] on 12 May 2005. R/O observed [REDACTED] operating a grey Pontiac Bonneville with an expired D/L sticker, at which time, R/O and R/O's partner, P.O. Dowling #19486, conducted a traffic stop. [REDACTED] demeanor from the time R/O and partner conducted said traffic stop to the time R/Os affected [REDACTED] arrest was resistance, desperation, and sheer panic.

[REDACTED], after being ordered several times by P.O. Dowling to place the above vehicle into park via the driver's side open window and after P.O. Dowling observed [REDACTED] holding a plastic bag containing smaller, individually knotted plastic bags each containing crack cocaine, ignored P.O. Dowling's orders, instead, [REDACTED] with the driver's side door open and after P.O.
