Subject: Home-Invasion Crimes Evidence Photo 8041 (5:37 a.m. 8-18-21 photo)

Thank you again, Detective Costello, for assuring me on the telephone this year that if I ever provide you with at least one photo of someone OTHER than myself who is physically present inside my current solo-occupancy double-bolt-locked efficiency apartment unit at Pebble Creek Apartments in NE Austin, you will authorize a forensic DNA-swabs sexual-assault-evidence medical exam on me at that time.

Attached, please find an infrared motion-sensitive-camera-generated photo of an alleged home-invasion-crimes perpetrator who was caught on camera inside my bedroom. This suspect appears to

be younger than age 64. I myself am a 64-year-old Anglo-Saxon gentleman of English, Scottish, and German ancestry.

So far in calendar year 2021, I have had only one total occasion in which anyone other than me has been permitted by me to enter or to be situated inside my bolt-locked rental-apartment unit between the hours of 6 p.m. in the evening and 8 a.m. in the morning.

That one total occasion, which occurred on the night of Monday, January 18, 2021, involved two total on-duty APD officers, APD Officer Hootman (Badge Number 8210) and APD officer McDowell (Badge Number 8241), who while working together entered my unit after I unlocked and opened the front door for them. They then obtained a sworn affidavit from me inside my apartment unit for APD Aggravated Robbery Case Number 21-0181172---a case relating to two apparent African-American male minors who approached me and threatened to stab or shoot me, and for which there was another witness to that crime. That second witness was an African-American male apartment security officer at a nearby apartment complex along North Plaza Drive, who provided APD with a separate and corroborating statement.

As you may recall, Detective Costello, I have been repeatedly and politely requesting APD authorization for a forensic DNA-swabs anal-rape-evidence exam on me on dozens of occasions ever since early 2012; and so far, each of those requests of mine have been declined by APD.

I have also repeatedly over a multi-year period requested that APD please obtain full 190-day retroactive DNA-traces processing of the two rape-evidence kits from me (for APD Sex Crimes Case 11-1180447 that was opened by APD on the morning of April 28, 2011, and for APD Sex Crimes Case 11-3550615 that was opened by APD on December 21, 2011, with the forensic DNA swabs rape-evidence medical exam on me having occurred here in Austin in the early morning hours of December 22, 2011) that your APD Sex Crimes Unit already has in storage at an APD-supervised facility here in Austin.

As you may be aware, Detective, each of my requests for full 190-day retroactive DNA-traces processing of those two rape-evidence kits have been declined by APD.

Finally, I would like to again emphasize that I have reported to APD several or more times in recent years that photo images obtained from an infrared motion-sensitive camera of mine appeared to show surprising evidence of movement occurring right near or at one or more walls to my bedroom. Back in December of 2015, when I resided in Apt. 902 of Building 9 at an apartment complex (Village Oaks Apts., 10926 Jollyville Road) in northwest Austin, an ADT staff member in New York State helpfully stated to me on the telephone that the lit-up quality and vibrations in the photo images of one or more walls of my locked bedroom that I obtained then as an ADT customer appeared to show evidence of actual movement of the wall along the northern side of my bedroom, for instance. The two adult tenants in that particular adjoining unit were apparently African-American, based on the accents they had when I overheard that couple having a loud verbal argument inside their unit at nighttime. I never spoke with those neighbors of mine at Village Oaks Apartments, and I myself never permitted them to enter my apartment unit. I am fairly sure that I did occasionally observe one or two adult African-Americans walking toward that second-floor, northern wing of Building 9 where the unit directly abutting my unit from the north was situated.

I hope to hear from you soon, Detective Costello.
