On March 21st, 2022, I was instructed to investigate complaint sent to the New York State
Commission of Correction from who is the brother of
the complaint claims in sum and or substance that while in custody his brother
was choked and punched in the face by Officer Dillion Powles 545 while in Garnet Health Medical
Center on 03/02/2022. He also claims that his brother sustained a black eye from getting punched in the face
by staff. I reviewed the complaint, logbook information, Officers memorandums, medical staff's incident reports
and handheld video. Upon review it was determined the incident in question was on 03/01/2022.
On 03/01/2022 Inmate. was in the GHMC Emergency Room due to a claim of a facial injury and
testicular pain. Inmate was secured to the bed in the emergency room by mechanical leg restraints
and mechanical hand restraints. Based on memorandums submitted by Officer Dillion Powles 545 and Per
Diem Officer Paul Lindau Inmate became irate when he was advised he would be getting
discharged from the Emergency Room. It was reported that at this time Inmate began hitting the
left and right side of his head on the bed rails profusely. Staff took control of Inmate head and chest
area to prevent further injury to Inmate and ordered him to stop his actions. After several orders
Inmate complied and ceased his actions. Approximately 30 minutes later while waiting to be
discharged Inmate began to again hit the left and right side of his head on the bedrails. GHMC
nursing staff was present in the room at this time and Correctional staff requested from them to have blankets
placed on the side of the bed rails to prevent Inmate from further injuring himself. As staff was attempting to remove the temporary hand restraints to accure Inmate
attempting to remove the temporary hand restraints to secure Inmate in a transport belt, he attempted to bite Officer Lindau's hand. Officer Powles tilted Inmate head back away from Officer

comply and was secured back to the bed in temporary hand restraints. The facility was notified by Officer
Powles and additional staff was sent to the hospital to transport Inmate back to the facility. Inmate






began to calm down and became compliant. He was secured in a transport belt and escorted back to the facility. I reviewed the medical incident report that medical staff completed upon Inmate return to the facility. In the report medical staff observed redness / abrasion to the left side of Inmate face. They also observed swelling to his right side of his face. At no time during his return evaluation did he claim to the nurse he was punched in the face or choked. At not time during the medical evaluation did medical staff observes redness around his neck nor a black eye. On 03/2/2021 Inmate was assessed by medical staff due to claiming he sustained injury at GHMC ER by staff. Medical staff observed some swelling to the right died of his face. At not time during the evaluation did they observe a black eye. X rays were taken of Inmate face and the findings were negative for abnormalities.
I also reviewed handheld video of when Inmate was escorted to Main Medical on 03/02/2022 and did not observe a black eye.
I could not interview Inmate on his claim due to him being released from custody on March 17th, 2022.
After review of all the facts received in this investigation I found Inmate claims to be unfounded. It was documented that Inmate was hitting the left and right side of his face on the bed rails multiple times. This is where Inmate received the redness and swelling to his face based on reports and memorandums submitted. Also, at no time did medical staff observe redness to Inmate reck area or did they observe a black eye. Review of the handheld video from the following day also did not show a black eye or redness to the neck area of Inmate End of memo.
