MEMORANDUM

On Tuesday April 09, 2019, I conducted an interview with Inmate [REDACTED] and an investigation pursuant to letters Administration received from [REDACTED] and the New York State Commission of Correction. [REDACTED] claims to be the mother of Inmate [REDACTED]. In her letter Ms. [REDACTED] expresses concern for the safety of Inmate [REDACTED]. During the interview I first questioned Inmate [REDACTED] if he was concerned about his safety. Inmate [REDACTED] relayed no safety concerns. Second, I questioned Inmate [REDACTED] if he has had any recent contact with his mother that would be concerned about his safety. Inmate [REDACTED] stated that he was being issued an Instant Adjudication on by Officer Byrnes, Kevin 310. Inmate [REDACTED] further stated that he told his mother via inmate phone that he was being locked in and that if she did not hear from him to call and check on him. Inmate [REDACTED] then laughed and said that he had forgotten to call her and that she was probably worried about him. I advised Inmate [REDACTED] to call his mother and let her know that he was fine. Inmate [REDACTED] did state that he currently has a Grievance against Officer Byrnes for discrimination. The Grievance was found to be without merit and forwarded to the Citizen's Policy and Complaint Review Council. Inmate [REDACTED] also has another Grievance against staff that is open. In the grievance, Inmate [REDACTED] makes no claims for concern of his safety, but does again claim discrimination. During the rest of the interview, Inmate [REDACTED] made no other complaints against staff, Medical, or Mental Health. Upon conclusion of the interview, I find Ms. [REDACTED] claims to be unfounded.
