Subject: Single Source Request - Annual Support Services for Single Space Parking Meter Equipment

The Office of Public Parking recommends approval of the single source renewal award with IPS Group, Inc. to continue providing parking meter equipment service, software maintenance and financial processing for the period of October 1, 2020 – September 30, 2021. Public Parking requests the ability to cancel this agreement at any time, or to change the agreement to new mutually agreeable terms in the event Public Parking's equipment inventory changes, by giving the vendor 30 days written notice.

All pricing and terms remain the same with a maximum amount not to exceed \$130,625.80 These meters, parts, and associated fees are unique to IPS Group Inc., and contracting is essential to replace or maintain existing equipment as well as to support monthly software/reporting costs.
