I am extremely proud of the men and women of our LBPd family for the bravery and professionalism displayed during yesterday's events. As you all know, yesterday there were thousands of demonstrators who expressed their First Amendment Rights during a [protest](#) over the tragic death of George Floyd.

To ensure those lawfully protesting were able to do so safely, and in our greatest effort to preserve order in our community, we deployed hundreds of officers to the Downtown Long Beach area as well as other critical locations in the city. Our officers and support staff worked tirelessly throughout the day and night. In addition, yesterday we received more than 4,600 calls for service, more than three times as many calls for service experienced on the same day last year.

I commend all you for your dedication, discipline and professionalism and for your ongoing commitment to protecting our community.

Today, we maintain a strong visible presence throughout the city, with the assistance of our mutual aid partners, and remain prepared to address any criminal activity that occurs by agitators and vandals destructing our community.

Due to the ongoing protests regarding the death of George Floyd, the entire Police Department went into a Tactical Alert since June 1st. All department personnel have been placed on 12-hour shifts and days off canceled. As a result, some of our resources have been redirected to directly support the department's mission of preservation of peace and protection of property as protests and civil unrest continue throughout the county.

With that being said, we haven't been able to efficiently conduct the lab checks originally submitted for the month of June. As of now, we don't have a timeline when the Department will resume back to normal operations. In an effort to deliver a high quality product to you, we have decided it would be best to postpone the labs and start again on July 1st. Please feel free to contact any of the shift supervisors or myself if you have any questions or concerns. We thank you in advance for your understanding and cooperation to work with us as we move forward through these challenging times.
