Everyone who witnessed a use of force is required to file a follow up report.

From I.A.:

Officers and Sergeants who responded to multiple locations as part of a strike team or rapid response team need to document their actions for each location where force was used. For example, if a group of officers responded to the PIKE outlets and used force on a group of looters who fled, that force needs to be documented in a DR and the Sergeant needs to do a Blue Team UOF report.

Our squad was assigned as the Arrest and Control Squad attached to the Special Weapons and Tactics Team. To be clear, if you were at any of these locations and you observed a use of force you are required to file per policy. I know we split the squad at one point so file for the following locations where SWAT had UOFs:

Bay / Paseo / Call 573

Broadway / Pine / Call 574

4th/Promenade - / Call 576

Long Beach Blvd/ Burnett / Call 578

I have attached the I.A. Guide for filing on Civil Unrest incidents. Sgt Everts will be the approving supervisor for your reports. Email him and CC me when your reports are completed and ready for review. The department understands that these reports are being filed more than a week later and the night was chaotic. File the best you can and if you have questions call me.
