I have enclosed a copy of the letter transmitted to the Attorney General today regarding your request. You will be notified when the Attorney General decides this issue.



Dear Attorney General Paxton:

The Dallas County Criminal District Attorney's Office timely requests a decision from your Office.

On March 15, 2023, the Dallas County District Attorney's Office received a Public Information Act (PIA) request from Gaby Caplan seeking four categories of information from the above numbered and referenced cause.
