On behalf of the City of Chicago Department of Assets, Information and Services (AIS) I am responding to your Freedom of Information Act FOIA requests dated **Monday, August 8, 2022, 10:52 PM**. You seek and state the following.

***Pursuant to the Illinois Freedom of Information Act., I hereby request the following records:***

***A copy of any reference service level agreements, contract amendments, cure notices, non-disclosure agreements, or other revisions to agreements to the current contract between this department, the city of Chicago, and ShotSpotter, Inc. The current publicly available contract (<https://webapps1.chicago.gov/vcsearch/city/vendors/102512086A/contracts>) does not include information regarding the extension through August 19, 2023. This records request includes the number of square miles covered and total cost of the extension.***

The Department of Assets, Information and Services (AIS) has reviewed your request, please be advised AIS does not manage any of the above-mentioned records. Therefore, AIS does not have any responsive records. Please note that each City department is a separate “public body” under Section 2 of FOIA. 5 ILCS 140/2(a); *Duncan Publishing, Inc. v. City of Chicago*, 304 Ill. App. 3d 778, 784 (1st Dist. 1999) (“Clearly, each of the individual departments are subsidiary bodies of the city and are ‘public bodies’ as defined by the FOIA.”). A FOIA request must be directed to the Department that maintains the records you seek. Please be advised that Shotspotter is a CPD program. AIS would have no information on this contract.

To the extent that you consider this a denial of your FOIA request, you have a right of review by the Illinois attorney General’s Public Access Counselor, who can be contacted at 500 S. Second St., Springfield, IL 62706 or by telephone at {217} 399-FOIA. You may also seek judicial review of a denial under 5 ILCS 140/11 of FOIA.
