INFORMATION/VENUE:

On 08/31/11 at approximately 0325 hours CenCom dispatched a robbery and assault that just occurred at 2503 Baymont Place. The victim was with an upstairs neighbor. I responded to assist. Enroute CenCom advised that medical aid was summoned.

Upon arrival I spoke with the caller, Larry Dee. Dee is an upstairs neighbor and said he rents the downstairs basement unit to the victim, Tarra Lawson.

He said approximately fifteen minutes prior to the incident he went downstairs to the shared laundry room though the inside stairwell. He knocked on the door and it was answered by a black male in his twenties he knows as "Jeremy." Jeremy was visiting Lawson. Dee placed laundry in the dryer and went back upstairs. Approximately fifteen minutes later he heard shouting and looked outside towards the back yard and observed "Jeremy" on top of Lawson. He appeared to be assaulting her. He was wearing a black hoodie. Dee went downstairs to assist. "Jeremy" was now gone and Lawson said that she was robbed. She was bleeding from her scalp. Dee did not see any other suspects.

I contacted Lawson.

Lawson was bleeding from a laceration on the left side of her scalp. She reported she was inside her apartment with "Jeremy." A knock was heard at the outer door. "Jeremy" answered the door and two males entered. She said she knows both of the males. One was identified as Ryan Snook, the other as "Anthony B." Anthony goes by the street name of "Fat boy." Snook is described as a white male in his twenties with a tattoo on his neck, 5'9", thin, with close cropped hair. Anthony "B" is described as a white male, 5'9", 260 pounds, and shaved head.

The two entered the residence and immediately demanded "Give me your shit!" and "Where's the shit?" She knew that they were asking for her safe, that contained approximately one ounce of marijuana (she advised that she uses it for medical reasons), 360 Vicoden (prescribed yesterday), and approximately \$2,500.00 in cash. She said Snook was holding a silver .22 semiautomatic pistol, pointed at her and said, "Give me your shit or I'll kill you!" She was attacked by both of the males and attempted to fight them off. They attempted to tie her up with duct tape. She was struck by one of the males with the pistol, causing the laceration to her head. She said that the pistol was passed back and forth between the two suspects. The two males went in to a back room where her safe was bolted to a work bench. One of the two tore the safe from the bench. They grabbed her purse and exited out the back

door, also with the safe. She chased after the males into the yard and the departed on foot.

In her grey Coach purse was: a white Iphone, a Bank of America debit card, Washington State driver's license, and approxmatley \$300.00 cash.

I asked her were "Jeremy" was and if he assaulted her. She said he must have left, and did not assault her. I asked how they would know that she had a safe. She implied that "Jeremy" may be involved.

Jeremy is described as a black male in his twenties, and goes by the street name of "Young Boog."

Lawson said that she is married and has another residence, but shares the apartment with her boyfriend, Isaac Miller. Miller is in Port Orchard with his girlfriend. She said that they use this residence for discreet relationships. Miller may know the positive identification of "Anthony" and "Jeremy."

BFD arrived end rendered medical aid. Officer Mayfield photographed the area and Lawson's injuries.

A K-9 track was conducted and terminated in the area of 26th Street and Lafayette Avenue. Officer Hall located a pair of tortoise shell sunglasses in that area, and a digital scale in the yard of the residence. I later entered those items into evidence.

I asked Lawson about the scale. She said that she uses it to weigh her marijuana. I asked her why she would weigh her medicinal marijuana. She said, "To make sure she gets the right amount." I retained a roll of duct tape that had visible blood on it. I later entered that item into evidence.


Lawson said that Snook, Anthony, and Jeremy often hang out with a male known as "Worm" that lives on Snyder Avenue near 19th Street. She also gave a contact phone number of 360-536-0047 for Anthony.

A Data return for Snook showed that he was a convicted felon. A triple I was requested and is attached to this report.

I spoke with Sgt. Renfro and he advised that Anthony Brandenburg goes by the street name of "Fat Boy" (Anthony B). An I/LEADS photo clearly matched the description given by Lawson.

INFORMATION: On 08/31/11 at or about 0325 hrs I responded to 2503 Baymont Place for a reported robbery with a 22 caliber handgun. The two white male suspects were reported to have fled on foot from the residence. One was described as heavy set with short hair and the other thinner.

K9 APPLICATION: I arrived on scene with Police Dog (PD) Chip and placed him in his tracking harness attached to a 30 foot lead, to utilize him as a search tool.

I contacted Officer Roessel who provided additional suspect information. See general report. Just prior to contacting Officer Roessel PD Chip had a change of behavior was began vigorously scenting near the southwest corner of the residence. I discovered a small, black electronic scale. I seized the scale and released it to Officer Roessel.

At 0330 hrs I started the track at the entrance doorway to the residence. This was the area where the suspects were last seen. On the search command PD Chip began scenting and working around the north side of the home. The track continued north on Baymont Place to 26th Street.

As PD Chip and I neared the intersection I observed a pair of tortuous shell sunglass lying on the shoulder of the street on the line of track. I seized the sunglasses and later released them to Office Roessel.

The tracked turned east and as we near Lafayette Avenue PD Chip indicated he was not tracking human scent. I worked him around the intersection and then backtracked to Baymont Place. I tried working PD Chip west toward Finney Bay without success.

At approximately 0349 hrs the track was secured.

It is believed the suspects may have had a vehicle in the area.

INFORMATION: On 08/31/2011 I was working uniformed patrol as the 3rd Watch sergeant for the Bremerton Police Department's Operations Division. I was wearing a fully marked Bremerton Police sergeant's uniform and driving a marked patrol car.

At approximately 0325 hrs. Cencom toned out a priority call at 2503 Baymont Place, City of Bremerton. The initial information was that the victim had been assaulted and was bleeding, and that the suspects were armed with a handgun.

I initially responded to the area and sat up on containment. A K9 track was attempted with negative results. After clearing containment, I drove to the victim residence.

I met with Ofc. Roessel who was in the downstairs basement / apartment interviewing the victim, Tarra Lawson. I noted that Lawson had an obvious laceration on her scalp, which was bleeding. Lawson had dried blood alongside her face, running down the side / front of her neck. Medical aid had arrived on scene and examined Lawson, and had departed the scene.

While on scene I heard Lawson tell Ofc. Roessel that one of the suspects was Ryan Snook. I know Snook from numerous contacts. Later, when I was approving and routing Ofc. Roessel's report, I noted that the other suspect went by the street name, "Fat Boy" and was also known by the victim as "Anthony B". I know "Fat Boy" to be the street name for Anthony Brandenburg and advised Ofc. Roessel of this. Additionally, I know that both Brandenburg and Snook have an extensive violent criminal history.

At one point while talking with Lawson, she did indicate that she had an ounce of marijuana in the safe that had been taken during the robbery. She was reluctant to talk about the marijuana, but did state that the safe also contained prescription pills and cash.

INFO: 09/01/2011 KCSO ran Anthony Brandenburg's data through CENCOM while on a detail in Port Orchard reference case number K11-009333. We advised CENCOM to alert KCSO of our PC to arrest Brandenburg for Robber 1. KCSO detained Brandenburg and requested we retrieve him.

OFC ACTIONS: With Sgt Endicott's approval I responded to Port Orchard and took Brandenburg into custody reference this case.

A search incident to arrest of Brandenburg's person made no discovery. Brandenburg was in possession of \$343 dollars in cash in various denominations he later advised he obtained from working for his uncle under the table.

Brandenberg asked what he was under arrest for. I explained he was under arrest for Robbery 1 and Burglary 1. Brandenburg had advised he "is pleading the 5th" and requested to be taken straight to jail because he would not speak with us. I advised Sgt. Endicott and transported him to the KCSO Jail for booking on the charges.

SPONTANIOUS STATEMENTS: During the transport to the jail Brandenburg ridiculed the justice system and said he would be out within 90 days. Brandenburg said "I did not know how the statements of one person could be enough to get me arrested for Robbery". I did not give Brandenburg any details or speak to him reference this case other than advising him of the charges.

While at the jail I made contact with a POPD officer who advised he arrested Keidron Henderson at the same detail as Brandenburg reference case number POPD-002482. I was further advised Henderson was arrested for a warrant and VUCSA Possession of a Scheduled narcotic. I was informed the pills located were Hydralcodone. I asked the Ofc for his case number believing they might be connected to the robbery.

Brandenberg had been taken into custody by jail staff and placed into the same holding cell with Henderson.

Brandenberg then advised jail staff that the cigarette pack Henderson was arrested with was his and that the "5 Vicadine" pills in the pack were also his. Brandenburg wanted to take responsibility for them.

MIRANDA WARNINGS: They escorted Brandenburg to an interview room where I read Miranda Warnings to Brandenburg from my department issued card. Brandenburg advised he understood his rights and would speak freely. I asked Brandenburg to tell me what was going on.

INTERVIEW BRANDENBERG: Brandenburg stated that he and Henderson were inside his friend's house when the police knocked on the door. Brandenburg said he was startled and ran inside the house. Brandenburg said the cigarette pack and Vicodin pills inside of it are his. Brandenburg said he had tossed the cigarette pack when he ran into the house. I asked Brandenburg if he had a prescription for the pills. Brandenburg said he did not. I asked Brandenburg why he was in possession of the pills and what he was doing with them. Brandenburg said he was, "not going into all of that." I asked Brandenburg where he got them and received the same answer. I advised Brandenburg I would add his statements to my report then had jail staff place him back in a holding cell.



9-1-11, I received this case for further investigation. Detective Sgt Crane later contacted me with information that Ryan Snook, who is believed to be one of the suspects in the robbery, was possibly staying in South Kingston with a male by the name of Terrence, unknown last name.

9-6-11, I contacted Tarra Lawson via phone, 360-286-8472. I asked Lawson how she was feeling. She told me at first she felt very strong but now she is noticing bruises all over her body and she is very stressed out. Lawson stated she is afraid the suspects will come back and hurt her. Lawson advised she is aware that Anthony Brandenburg had been arrested but she has concerns since Ryan Snook is still running around. Lawson told me she is having friends stay with her and she hopes to move soon. Lawson advised she has a house with her husband but because she has been seeing Isaac Miller she moved into 2503 Baymont Place so they would have a place to hang out. Lawson advised she is afraid since the robbery took place and is thinking about moving back in with her husband.

Lawson advised she does not like to stay at home alone so the night of the robbery, 8-31-11, she had Jeremy, a black male who goes by the street name of Young Boog, stay with her. Lawson advised she does not know Jeremy's last name but her boyfriend, Isaac Miller, and Jeremy have been friends for a long time. Lawson believes that Jeremy set up the robbery for Brandenburg and Snook to come and steal her belongings. Lawson advised she has talked to her boyfriend, Miller, about this belief and he is very mad but does not want to believe that Jeremy is involved. Lawson told me that Miller told her a couple weeks ago Jeremy asked if it would be okay if he stole Vicodin from Lawson, and Miller told him no.

Lawson advised she had just received her Vicodin, 360 pills worth, the day before the robbery took place. Lawson told me she receives 360 Vicodin per month and Jeremy was aware she had just received them. Lawson advised Jeremy hangs out with Brandenburg and Snook, and she believes they planned the robbery.

Lawson advised that Brandenburg came over in July. She met Brandenburg through her boyfriend, Miller. At that time Brandenburg was not using drugs at all. Brandenburg helped her with some projects around the house at that time. Lawson advised that Brandenburg got drunk one night recently and started using meth again, and possibly Oxycontin. Lawson advised she has not seen Brandenburg since the robbery took place. Prior to that Brandenburg stayed with her for about four days. She fed him so he could recover from drugs.

Lawson advised she has known Snook for a while too through her boyfriend, Miller. She knows Snook is addicted to Oxy and has been using for at least one year. He also uses methamphetamine but she does not know how much he uses.

Lawson told me that Brandenburg and Snook have no money and they both use drugs heavily. Lawson has been told that Brandenburg and Snook have also robbed several of their friends she knows but none of them are willing to talk to the police. Lawson advised the friends are afraid of Brandenburg and Snook and don't trust the police to report the incident.

Lawson told me she is not used to the street life and she is more than willing to talk to the police and prosecute Brandenburg and Snook. Lawson told me she is a registered nurse. She owns her own house. She recently had a back injury and that is why she takes Vicodin and has a marijuana prescription. Not too long ago she was arrested and PR'd on her own recognizance, and Brandenburg thought she was a snitch because she got out and he started telling people she was a snitch.

Lawson advised that her boyfriend Isaac Miller, Anthony Brandenburg, Ryan Snook, and Jeremy unknown last name, are all in the gang "Gangster Disciples." Lawson advised that Miller has not been in trouble for a long time but still knows these people from his past.

Lawson advised she has been trying to find where Snook is hanging out but no one is telling her where he is. Everyone says they do not know where he is.

Lawson advised that Jeremy has been calling her a lot and trying to plea his case that he was not involved. Lawson advised that Jeremy has not called her and he is only calling Miller.

Lawson told me the night of the robbery, Jeremy had been staying with her and there was a knock at the door about 3:00 a.m. Jeremy let the suspect(s) in and they both had bandanas covering their faces. Lawson advised they pointed a gun at her and Jeremy did not do anything to help her. When the two suspects took off, Jeremy also took off and she has not seen him since. Lawson advised the suspects knew where her safe was and took the safe.

Lawson told me Jeremy stays with her often to protect her when Isaac Miller is not around. I asked her what she needs protection from. She said she is just afraid and does not like to stay home alone.

Lawson advised Jeremy knows where her safe is and that she had the Vicodin and marijuana in it. He also had access to the key to unlock the safe and the key is now missing. Both Snook and Brandenburg have been to her house because they are all friends with Isaac Miller. Lawson advised a few other friends of Millers who have been to the house are Rodrequiz Rogers, Parnell (unknown last name), and Santos (unknown last name). Lawson advised since the robbery occurred, she is afraid to stay home alone and she is lonely so she's thinking about going back home to her husband. Lawson explained that Miller does not live with her; he lives in Port Orchard with his family. Miller does hang out with her during the day. I asked Lawson how she knows Miller and how long she has known him. She advised she has known Miller for 15 years but she had not seen him until May 2011, and they have been together ever since.

Lawson advised she saw Ryan Snook's girlfriend's Facebook. Her name is Cassandra (last name unknown) and she lives by Evergreen Park in Bremerton. Cassandra has been saying she does not know where Snook is staying but on her Facebook she wrote that he is staying across the Hood Canal Bridge or possibly in Belfair "in the woods."

I asked Lawson how she knows that it was Snook and Brandenburg if they had bandanas over their faces. She said she knows them both very well and they talked to her and called her by name. Lawson advised that Jeremy had asked Miller if he could "jack her" for her Vicodin and marijuana while she was gone. Miller told him no. Lawson stated so they did it anyways and they did it while she was home.

I asked Lawson if she has cancelled her bank cards, and she said no but she did check them and they have not been used. I advised her she should cancel the cards. I asked Lawson if she cancelled her iPhone or turned it off. She said no but she purchased another one. Lawson told me she did get another Vicodin prescription

since she has chronic back pain but she cannot afford to pick up the prescription. Lawson advised she usually takes 12 Vicodin a day but right now she can only afford to buy 4 at a time so she is taking 4 Vicodin a day.

Once again Lawson said her entire safe was stolen, the key was taken from her key ring, and the following people had access to the key; Rodrequiz, Santos, and Jeremy, and all of them are friends with Snook and Brandenburg.

Lawson advised that when the two suspects, Brandenburg and Snook, came into her house, Snook tried to cover her with a pillow and duct tape her but she was able to fight him off. At that time Brandenburg had the gun pointed at her. One of them hit her in the head with the gun but she is not sure which one. Snook went in and cut the bolts from the table that were connected to the safe. At that time Brandenburg had the gun on her, and Jeremy was lying on the bed not doing anything to stop them. Lawson advised that once they were outside, Snook took off with the gun since he is much faster than Brandenburg. Brandenburg then had the safe so she thought she could fight him and maybe get her stuff back but she was unable to and Brandenburg took off with the safe and her purse. Lawson advised she was screaming and Brandenburg kept telling her to be quiet. Lawson advised that Brandenburg tried to tie her up again so she could not call the police but she fought with him and he grabbed her purse, the safe, and took off.

I asked Lawson if she saw or heard a vehicle in the area. She said no. She said the K-9 did try to track them but lost the scent. Lawson advised she is now afraid because Rodrequez told her if she cooperates with the police, Brandenburg has told him he has friends with the Bandidos and they will take care of her. Lawson advised now everyone is talking about her being a snitch and she is afraid of retaliation.

Lawson advised she has a friend at her house now, Jordan (unknown last name), that Snook and Brandenburg attacked two weeks ago. Jordan told her he was lured to a house and beat up for his marijuana. She asked Jordan if he would talk to me and he said no, he was not going to talk to the police.

Lawson told me she has heard Snook and Brandenburg have been robbing drugs and money from several people they know but they are all afraid to talk to the police. Lawson advised she feels she has Post Traumatic Stress Syndrome now from the incident. I advised Lawson I would be doing follow-up, and she told me she would contact me if she hears where Snook is or any other information.

### INFORMATION / VENUE:

04-10-12, 0840 hrs, I was contacted by Sgt Crane in reference to this incident. Sgt Crane advised that Detective Gray has been assigned the follow-up to this investigation but is unavailable at this time. Sgt Crane handed me a report generated by KCSO Deputy Manchester in reference to information he had received from a CI (confidential source of information) that a subject by the name of Jeremy Fenney was talking about being involved in the home invasion robbery where victim Lawson was robbed and assaulted, and a safe was taken from her residence. The CI advised that Fenney was stating he had set up the robbery and was an accomplice to suspects Ryan Snook and Anthony Brandenburg. The CI also advised Fenney stated he had texted Brandenburg with information the residence was clear and to go ahead and make contact at the residence to rob the victim. He played along as a victim to cover his involvement.

Sgt Crane advised Fenney was due to be released from the KCSO jail on 04-11-12, and requested I interview Fenney and take a statement from him in regards to his involvement in the home invasion robbery.

I researched Fenney in the I/Leads records system and found a record for him also listing his street moniker as Young Boog. This is also indicated in the report where witness Lawson only knew Fenney by the first name of Jeremy and stated he went by the street name of Young Boog and was a Gangster Disciple.

### PHOTOMONTAGE COMPLETED:

04-10-12, I completed a computer generated photomontage, placing suspect Fenney's photograph in the #2 position. I also made two black and white photocopies of the montage.

### ATTEMPT TO CONTACT TARRA LAWSON:

04-10-12, 0950 hrs, I attempted contact with Lawson at her residence of 4945 Bowwood Circle NE. I knocked on the door and it was answered by a black male who identified himself as Lawson's husband. He stated Lawson was in prison at Mission Creek and would be there for approximately 8 to 10 more months. I thanked him for the information and cleared the contact.

### CONTACT LARRY DEE:

04-10-12, 1030 hrs, I contacted Larry Dee at his residence of 2503 Baymont Place. I advised Dee of the reason for the contact and he stated he was aware of the incident and wanted to know if he was going to be needed in court. I stated one of the subjects involved has already pled guilty and was now in prison and I was doing follow-up in reference to the identification of a possible third suspect. I asked Dee if he could provide anymore information about the subject he saw in the laundry room who he knew as Jeremy. Dee stated he could not provide anymore information on Jeremy with the exception that he was a light skinned black male and his body was covered in numerous tattoos. I asked him if this is the same subject he had observed in the back yard of the residence on top of Lawson, assaulting her. He stated that wasn't a true statement and it wasn't Jeremy assaulting Lawson, it was the bigger heavier-set male who robbed Lawson with the other subject. I asked him if he was positive about that. He stated he was very positive about that. I asked Dee if he would be willing to look at a photomontage containing photographs of six subjects. Dee stated he would look at the montage.

### PHOTOMONTAGE SHOWN:

04-10-12, I completed a Bremerton Police Department Photomontage Form and explained it to Dee. He also reviewed the form, signed and dated it at the bottom. I also signed as a witness. I advised Dee I was going to show him a photomontage that contained the photographs of six subjects. I asked Dee to look at the montage and tell me if he recognized anybody and if he recognized anybody to tell me how he recognized them. I did not tell Dee that Fenney's photograph was in the montage. I then showed the photomontage to Dee and he immediately, upon looking at the montage, pointed to the picture of Fenney in the #2 position. I asked Dee how he knew the subject in photo #2. He stated it was Jeremy and Jeremy was the subject at Lawson's residence and in the laundry room.

I asked Dee to circle the photograph of Fenney on a black and white copy of the montage, date and sign the bottom of the photograph. Dee then circled the photograph of Fenney in the #2 position and then signed and dated the bottom of the photo. I thanked Dee for his cooperation and cleared.

### INTERVIEW OF JEREMY FENNEY:

04-10-12, 1320 hrs, I contacted Fenney at the KCSO jail and escorted him to an interview room at the jail. I confirmed Fenney's identity with his jail photo bracelet and through his booking photograph from I/Leads. I advised Fenney I wanted to talk with him in regards to what he had witnessed during the incident at Lawson's residence. Fenney asked me why he was being talked to now. I advised him he had never been contacted during the investigation of the incident and a statement needed to be taken from him. Fenney stated okay. I advised Fenney because he was in custody on unrelated charges and not free to go, I was going to advise him of his Miranda warnings. I then advised Fenney of his Miranda warnings from my department issued rights card. Fenney stated he understood his rights and would talk with me.

I asked Fenney to tell me what happened on the night of 8-31-11 at Lawson's apartment. Fenney stated Lawson is the girlfriend of his cousin, Isaac Miller, and he was staying with Lawson to help her as she was afraid to stay by herself. He stated they were at the residence smoking meth and he was extremely high on meth. While in the apartment, there was a knock on the door and Lawson told Fenney to wait a minute while she hid the drugs and drug paraphernalia that were out in plain view, and then she went into the back room of the residence. Fenney stated he opened the front door and two males were standing there with bandanas over their faces. One of the subjects, who he described as a big heavy-set male, stuck a gun in his face and told him to back up. Fenney stated the gun was silver in color. He said he backed up and they told him to lie down on the bed. He stated he basically fell backward onto the bed and laid there. He stated the subjects then went into the back area of the residence and stole what he believed was a safe that belonged to Lawson. I asked him if the subjects stated anything. Fenney stated the bigger guy stated "I want the stuff, I want the stuff." I asked him if he recognized either subject. He stated he did not recognize either one.

I asked him why he ran away after the incident and did not stay and give a statement to the police. Fenney stated he was very high on meth and was scared so he ran away. I asked Fenney if he was positive he didn't know who either of the two subjects were. Fenney stated he did not. At this time I confronted Fenney with information that I knew he knew the subjects as Anthony Brandenburg and Ryan Snook. Fenney stopped talking at this point and looked at me. I observed his eyes get real wide and he stated, "How do you know I know them?" I advised Fenney I had received information that he and Brandenburg and Snook were acquaintances and hang out together. Fenney stated "Yeah I know it was Brandenburg and Ryan Snook." Fenney stated at the time of the robbery, because he was so high on meth, he did not realize it was Brandenburg and Snook but later, when he started to come down from his high, he knew it was Brandenburg and Snook who had committed the robbery.

I then confronted Fenney with the information I received that he was also involved in the robbery and he set

up the robbery and he had texted Brandenburg with an all clear signal so they could come in and rob the residence. Fenney again looked at me and I observed his eyes to get real wide. I also observed Fenney to also kind of slump down in the chair and take a deep breath. Fenney then stated he was not involved in the robbery and did not set up the robbery. I asked Fenney if he was positive he was not involved and did not set up the robbery. He again denied having any involvement in the robbery and stated he was a victim.

I asked Fenney if he would take a CVSA examination to determine whether he was being truthful or not. Fenney stated he would be more than willing to take the CVSA but would call me when he got out of jail to set up the appointment to do so and he did not want to do it at this time. I advised Fenney to call me when he got out of jail so we could set up the CVSA. I provided Fenney with my business card so he could contact me. I then returned Fenney to the jail staff and cleared.

### CONVERSATION WITH DPA KEVIN HULL:

04-10-12, 1440 hrs, I spoke with Kevin Hull at the prosecutor's office and advised him of the information I had received in regards to this incident and the possible involvement of Fenney and the robbery. Hull advised to complete my reports and forward it to the prosecutor's office for review and they would contact Deputy Manchester and find out the credibility of his CI. He also stated they would review the report and determine whether to recharge Ryan Snook with robbery in reference to this incident.

AGENCY ASSIST TO BPD CASE B11-008414  On 03-19-2012 I met with a confidential source in an interview room at the Kitsap County Jail. The source provided good information on warrant subjects that I was told were "on the run". I was able to arrest one of the subjects for a warrant. I also gathered information from the source about a second warrant subject, his current location, and the vehicle that he is driving. That investigation is ongoing.  The source also advised he had information that a black male named JEREMY FENNEY, who the source stated is a known Gangster Disciple gang member with the street name "Young Boog", was involved in a home invasion robbery. The source stated the robbery was in Bremerton, and that RYAN SNOOK and ANTHONY "Fatboy" BRANDENBURG participated in it. The source advised that BRANDENBURG was already sent to prison for this robbery. The source did not believe that FENNEY had yet been identified as a suspect in the case.  I was somewhat familiar with the basic details of this home invasion, as I had previously read the report and was working the night that BRANDENBURG was taken into custody on the PC for the robbery, which occurred in August of 2011. It should also be noted that I am familiar with JEREMY FENNEY, as I assisted with the investigation of a felony assault involving FENNEY's then girlfriend ALISHIA D. CRETOL (K12-012530). During that investigation, I became aware of FENNEY and multiple officer safety issues related to him being a gang member and possibly being armed with a handgun. During the course of the DV investigation, FENNEY was arrested on Perry Avenue and his truck was impounded. I met WSP Trooper M. WOOD at the South County Evidence Lot, where WOOD and his K9 partner did a sniff around the outside of FENNEY's black dodge pick-up. I recalled looking inside the vehicle and seeing a large sticker decal, or similar, related to the Gangster Disciples, that was covering the center console area in the middle of the front seat of JEREMY's truck.  After completing my interview with the source, I conducted research in ILEADS and located the above described home invasion robbery incident, reported on under Bremerton Police Case number B11-008414. The incident is being investigated by Bremerton Police Detective Crystal Gray. After reviewing the report, it was clear that the source provided good information about this case, as a male present at the home invasion was described by the victim as a black male named JEREMY, who went by the name "Young Boog". The victim believed that JEREMY had set up the robbery.  I also looked at JEREMY FENNEY's booking photos and he has "Young Boogyman" tattooed													

on the left side of his neck. Upon completion of my research in ILEADS, I began email correspondence with Detective Gray of BPD, in an attempt to arrange a meeting between her, myself, and my source. A tentative date was set during the first week of March, but the meeting did not happen due to Detective Gray being ill that day.

On 04-07-2012 I responded to the Jail and made contact once again with the source in an interview room. I learned that approximately 3 weeks ago, the source was sitting around a table at the Jail's cell block D, with JEREMY FENNEY, ALEXANDER KUTZE and possibly a few other unknown subjects. FENNEY, who is a known associate of BRANDENBURG's, was asked if he knew anything about the home invasion involving victim TARRA LAWSON. FENNEY said, "yeah I was there" and "I set the whole thing up". FENNEY then went into a story about how he was at the residence and TARRA LAWSON was smoking meth. FENNEY told the source and the others that he set the robbery up, and texted BRANDENBURG something similar to "yeah the coast is clear come on in". FENNEY said that he was laying on the ground, pretending to be a victim, when BRANDENBURG and another male came in with guns. At one point LAWSON asked FENNEY if he had his gun on him so FENNEY could protect her. FENNEY told her no and that it was in his car. FENNEY told the group that LAWSON was hit in the head with a gun by BRANDENBURG, and then hit in the head with the safe, and that "she wasn't going down without a fight". FENNEY told the group that he, BRANDENBURG, and another male, got about 1500 dollars and a bunch of pills out of the safe as a result of the robbery. FENNEY was asked if RYAN SNOOK was present, and FENNEY gave a strange look and said no. The source said he felt FENNEY was hinting that he was not willing to tell on SNOOK, but the source said it was obvious by FENNEY's words and strange look that SNOOK was in fact there. It should be noted that my research of the incident in ILEADS is consistent with what FENNEY stated occurred, with the exception of his claim that SNOOK was not present.

At one point during my interview, the source agreed to view a booking photo of JEREMY FENNEY. The source positively identified FENNEY as the person that admitted to setting up the home invasion robbery. I asked the source if he remembered anything about the others that were present during the story. The source stated he could only for sure identify KUTZKE as being present, and was not sure of the names of the other inmates that were present during the story.

The source also advised me that LAWSON is currently in prison for an unknown reason.

The source did not want his name listed in any reports, because he knows what these gangsters are all about and is fearful of retaliation. The source was advised that he may have to be identified at some point.

I checked with Kitsap County Jail staff and FENNEY is in custody in the D block until April 11th, at which time he is set to be released. FENNEY has the pending Assault 2nd DV case involving victim CRETOL, and is due in court for that matter at the end of the month.

I was informed by Jail staff that KUTZE is currently in-custody in the D block, and is due to be sentenced within a few weeks for the felony charge he is being held on.

## **Statement of Probable Cause**

8/31/2011 at approximately 0325 Hrs Officer Roessel responded to 2503 Baymont Place in Bremerton, Washington for a Robbery and Assault which just occurred.

Officer Roessel contacted Tarra Lawson who lives at 2503 Baymont Place. Lawson was bleeding from a laceration on the left side of her head. Lawson stated she was in her residence with Jeremy, a black male (unknown last name) when someone knocked on the door. Jeremy answered the door and two males entered the residence. Lawson identified the two males: Anthony "B" AKA "Fat Boy" (Anthony James Brandenburg 12/25/1988) and Ryan Dale Snook 9/3/1982. Brandenburg is described as a white male, 5'9", and 260 pounds with a shaved head. Snook is described as a white male, 5'9", thin, close cropped hair and a tattoo on his neck.

Lawson advised Brandenburg and Snook entered her residence and demanded "Give me your shit!" and "Where's the shit?" Lawson advised they were asking for her safe, which contained approximately one ounce of marijuana (medical purposes), 360 Vicodin (prescribed yesterday) and approximately \$2,500.00 cash. Lawson advised Snook was holding a silver .22 semiautomatic pistol, pointed at her and said, "Give me your shit or I'll kill you!" Lawson advised Snook attempted to cover her with a pillow and duct tape but she was able to fight him off. At that time Brandenburg had the gun pointed at her. Lawson was struck by one of the males (unknown which one) with the pistol, causing the laceration on her head. Lawson advised the males passed the pistol back and forth during the Robbery. Snook went to the back room where her safe was bolted to a work bench and cut the bolts and took the safe. Snook took off from the residence on foot with the gun. Brandenburg grabbed her purse along with the safe and took off out the back door.

Lawson advised in her grey Coach purse (\$400 value) was a white I phone (\$300 value), Bank of America debit card, Washington State driver's license and approximately \$300.00 cash.

Lawson believes Jeremy "Young Boog" may have been involved since he took off when Brandenburg and Snook left the residence.



A data return showed that Snook is a convicted Felon.

A known source who wants to remain anonymous advised Ryan Snook was leaving the State.

9/6/2011 I contacted Tarra Lawson who advised she is afraid that Brandenburg and Snook will come back and hurt her for reporting the robbery to the police. Lawson advised she is aware Brandenburg has been arrested but Snook has not.

9/29/2011 there have been several attempts to contact Ryan Snook with negative results. Request Ryan Dale Snook (9/3/1982) is charged with Assault in the Second Degree, Burglary in the First degree, Robbery in the First Degree and Unlawful Possession of a Firearm.
