City of Dallas v. Paxton, No. D-1-GN-19-005961

Dear Ms. Best:

Please be aware that the City of Dallas ("City") has filed the above-styled and numbered suit in the 459th Judicial District Court of Travis County. The suit challenges a decision of Ken Paxton, Attorney General of Texas, under subchapter G of Open Records Act, Texas Government chapter 552. The decision relates to your May 31, 2019, request for public information to the City, specifically, your request for information pertaining to Anonymous, the hacker movement.

As you know, on June 17, 2019, the City requested a decision from the attorney general about whether some of the information you requested was excepted from mandatory public disclosure under chapter 552. The attorney general assigned the identification number 782738 to your request. On August 28, 2019, the City received the attorney general's decision, number 2019-23759, concluding that some of the requested information that the City sought to withhold is subject to required public disclosure under chapter 552.

In this case, the City sues for a judgment determining that some of the information at issue is excepted from required public disclosure, despite the attorney general's decision to the contrary.

This case is only against the attorney general. You have a right not to participate in the case, but you also have a right to intervene if you wish.
